



I-Corp Replacement Token Quick Guide

1. Contact Treasury Solutions Support at 855-342-3400. Tell the representative you need to activate your replacement token. The representative will verify your identity to begin the enablement process.
2. Go to firstinterstate.com and log into I-Corp using your Username and Password.

4. Enter the 8-digit one-time password generated by the token.
5. Enter a 4-digit PIN of your choice.
6. Complete the Security question and answer.
7. Click **Continue**.

Activate Token

Tokens help to prevent unauthorized people from logging into online banking or doing things like making payments by generating a code that must be entered into online banking along with a personal identification number (PIN) that you will define.
