

Switch Checklist

This checklist is to help you identify all the companies you have authorized to make deposits or automatically withdraw funds from your account.

Who makes direct deposits to your account?

- Employer's human resource department
- The company handling your retirement/pension payments
- Social Security Administration

Who withdraws automatic payments from your account? This may be in the form of an automatic withdrawal or an authorized charge to your credit card/debit card.
